**The "Fair Play" Project**

A 72 acre undeveloped parcel of land including 22 acres of natural woods in Circleville, Ohio has been recently named the *Mary Virginia Crites Hannan Community Park*. This park will be the **first ever** city owned park for Circleville with the sole intent to develop the space to allow all citizens, regardless of age and physical ability, to enjoy the desperately needed experience of leisure and outdoor play. The "Fair Play" Project for this community park will generate: *A Boundless Playground; Amphitheater; "Splash Pad;" Rolling green space and open play space; Natural wetlands with observation deck; Environment education areas; Bird-watching areas; Four Season Shelter House; Outdoor winter ice rink; 1.2 miles of 10 foot wide paved walking paths -- additional paved paths connecting all active and passive areas and facilities; Three additional hiking paths through the woods; a Dog Park; and, a Community Building.*
